TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE OF BOOKINGS

Booking of courses, bookings will only be accepted on receipt of the appropriate fee.

If your course requires you to attend Open Water training, you will be need to pay any fees at each venue on each day you attend.

Equipment is included for all swimming pool experiences and students in training on Open Water Courses. For all other programs kit is not included within the course price.

All students must purchase a mask and snorkel for hygiene.

Right to terminate booking

It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure that the candidate(s) are suitable to become Diver before they are booked onto a course. Due to the Physical and Mental requirements of such a position, **Planet Scuba School** reserves the right to ask a student to leave the course or prevent them from taking the relevant exam, if the Course Instructor decides that the student is unsuitable for such a course. Normally the candidate will be advised of the Instructor's reasons for making such a decision. However, **Planet Scuba School** reserves the right to withhold this information without reason.

Cancellation of a course by Planet Scuba School

Planet Scuba School reserves the right to cancel or amend Course dates, times, venues or content at short or no notice as operational requirements dictate. Candidates will be notified of such changes as soon as possible, however, **Planet Scuba School** will not be held liable for any costs incurred by the candidate as a result of such changes or cancellations.

Cancellation of booking by candidate

Planet Scuba School reserves the right to charge the following cancellation fees should a student not be able to attend or fails to attend a course or if the candidate cancels the course.

Cancellation up to 6 weeks before the start date deposit £100.00

Cancellation between 1-4 weeks before the start date £150

Cancellation less than one week before the start date full payment.

Attendance of students on courses

Any change in course dates will result in an administration fee for each and every change made and unless otherwise agreed. I understand I must complete my course in full within 90 days of the course date or be liable for additional administration fees. Students must attend all sessions of any course run by **Planet Scuba School** otherwise they will not be issued with a successful completion certificate and where applicable, take the full final exam. Students using their own diving equipment must inform the course instructor who will decide if it is suitable.

Prerequisite qualifications

Where it is a requirement that a student must hold a specific qualification, or have completed particular training, prior to attending a specific Course, the student will not be allowed on the said course. If it is found that they do not hold the relevant (valid) certificate or if they have not completed the particular form of training required they be will be asked to leave. In the case of Instructor Training Courses all students must provide copies of their dive credentials and medical. Under the Regulations, students who do not hold these qualifications will either not be allowed onto the course or if they have already been accepted, will be asked to leave.
